Exciting Language Developments at Macrae Seafood in Fraserburgh

Industrious are extremely pleased to have been involved in a successful joint language support project at The Seafood Company's Macrae Foods site in Fraserburgh. Over a three month period, 33 Industrious workers undertook a formal 10 week ESOL course with instructors from the Banff and Buchan Academy. The course was held on site at Macrae Fraserburgh, and consisted of 90 minute taught classes and 90 minute conversation classes. Industrious' Contract Manager, Valeriya Wisely, and Contract Coordinator Shirley Henderson assisted in both preparation and running of the course, and delivering the conversational classes.



Our candidates were then reassessed using our Eucanlearn Capability Assessment system; and they achieved excellent results. Over 50% of candidates who undertook the ESOL course improved their results from Entry Level 1 in numeracy and literacy to Entry Level 2 or higher. A similar increase was recorded in candidate's understanding of Health and Safety instructions.
